# **2018-2019 School Supply List - Toddler**

(Please bring supplies any time over the summer or to Parent Orientation)

## **General-Supporting All Students – Do not label**

- 1 Pkg. washable crayons
- 1 Pkg. washable water color set
- 1 Pkg. washable markers
- 2 containers of play dough ( color of your choice)
- 2 boxes facial tissue
- 3 boxes powder- free disposable gloves- large (not food gloves)
- 2 cleaning towels/rags (any color)
- 2 Containers glitter
- 1 box gallon zip bags
- 1 box quart size zip bags
- 1 back sponges

# **2018-2019 School Supply List – Early Education & Kindergarten**

## **General – Supporting All Students – Do not label**

- 1 pkg. of washable markers (Crayola washable brand are preferred )
- 1 pkg. of washable watercolors
- 1 pkg. of colored pencils
- 1 pkg. of #2 pencils – not mechanical (Dixon Ticonderoga)
- 1 folder: plastic 2-pocket w/ grommets
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pkg. of copy paper
- 1 pkg. of dry erase markers (regular size, not skinny)
- 2 box of facial tissues
- 1 pkg. of sponges
- A change of clothes (uniform) to include socks and underwear-labeled with your child’s name, in a gallon bag – labeled with their name

## **Optional donations for the community**

- 1 pkg. of washcloths
- Construction paper
- 1 box of washable crayons

## **Kindergarten Only – label with your child’s name:**

- 1 story writing composition book with a space to draw a picture on top and lines on the bottom for writing
- 1 flat-clip standard size clipboard
- 1 - 3”x5” Steno pad

**Please do not bring the following:** Backpacks, pencil boxes, or extra items.

## 2018-2019 School Supply List – Junior Elementary

Some items are for the community and intended to be shared with classmates and others are personal. Be sure to mark your name on personal items only. Labeling these items ahead of time will make the first day more efficient.

### General – Supports All Students – Don't label

- 1 box colored pencils
- 2 box of #2 pencils – not mechanical (Dixon Ticonderoga)
- 2 sets dry erase markers
- 1 dry erase eraser
- 1 glue stick
- 1 package white copy paper
- 1 pkg. of 100 white, lined index cards
- 1 pkg. of sticky tabs
- 1 standard 12 inch ruler

### Personal Items – Label with student's name

- Composition Notebooks  
1<sup>st</sup> 5 Primary  
Composition books **with dashed middle line** for handwriting-- not spiral bound  
1 4x6 steno pad  
2<sup>nd</sup> 5 **wide ruled**  
composition books – not spiral bound  
3<sup>rd</sup> 5 composition books – not spiral bound
- 3 **durable, plastic**, 2 pocket grommet folders (1 solid red, 1 blue and 1 green)

- Low profile clip Clipboard (must fit in cubby)
- 1 pair of earbuds or headphones labeled in Ziploc bags

## 2018-2019 School Supply List – Senior Elementary

Parents please follow the list exactly. While shopping please consider if certain items will distract your child, for example, a hand held pencil sharpener in the shape of an airplane, and avoid such items. Extra items will be sent home. 6th graders are the only ones allowed to bring a backpack for their Math textbook. All other students may bring a Montessori Academy drawstring bag available for purchase at the front office.

### General

Please label all personal items and place them in your pencil box before the first day of school.

- 1 standard-size pencil box (Approx. 5x8 inches)
- 12-pack of #2 pencils
- 1 three-ring binder (no more than 1.5" thick) – for science (4<sup>th</sup> grade and new students only)
- 6<sup>th</sup> grade only – backpack to carry math textbook
